Dear Friends,

When ten year old Yohan dropped out of school in order to help support his parents and younger siblings by guarding cattle for a local farmer, it appeared he would be doomed to the same life of abject poverty as his parents. However, a village elder brought him to the Jehovah Shammah Children's Home where he was fed, clothed and sent to school. Here he was introduced to Jesus and where, in his own words, he "grew strong in the Lord". Because he was a good student they sent him to university where he received a degree in mathematics and in education. He now teaches in a nearby school. Yohan volunteers at JSCH visiting and providing counsel. He closed his testimony by saying "Jesus is my counselor and controller. I love Him and want to serve Him throughout my life."



- Your funds have enabled our partner children's homes to care for children whose parents died, abandoned them, or simply could not feed them. Many graduates of these homes now serve as nurses, teachers, or pastors.
- Your funds have helped to encourage village evangelists who, in spite of persecution, continue to share the gospel and plant new churches where there had been none.
- Your funds have made it possible for us to ship thousands of books to Bible schools and seminaries in places where such books are simply not available.
- Your giving has made it possible to keep hundreds of children in partner schools where they are not only gaining knowledge but are also learning of the love of Christ and learning to share it in their communities.

Just \$30 per month will provide care for a child in one of our partner children's homes and just \$20 per month provides pastor evangelists with tools for sharing the gospel. \$10 per month makes it possible for a student, who otherwise might not go to school, to attend one of the Christian schools run by our partners.

We need your help to ensure that our partners can continue to share the Good News in some of the most challenging and hostile places and to rescue destitute children, provide care for widows, and disciple and train dedicated Christian workers.
