PARTNERSHIP IN KENYA LED BY JULIAN ORIMBO

In June, we told you about the closure of all high school boarding schools due to a series of arson fires that caused significant damage and loss of life. Eight of Julian's high school students have been sent home indefinitely until the authorities determine that it is safe for students to return. Two of Julian's teachers have agreed to tutor them until they can return to their schools.

Although the presence of the high school students has added to her expenses, Julian reported that her joy has increased because of the opportunity to work with and counsel the teens who are eager to study and to discuss God's word.

Julian, with funds received from EWI, was able to send ladies to the Nairobi national ladies Christian conference. She chose nine specific ladies who will be able to share what they learned with others after their return.

How did your gifts make a difference? The two meals a day that EWI supports is the reason that many of the more than 300 students attend Julian's k-9 Christian school where they hear the gospel, participate in Bible studies and are said to have a positive influence on non-believing parents. Funding in support of church outreach events, women's and youth seminars, and children's camps has led to dozens of changed lives and is impacting entire communities.
